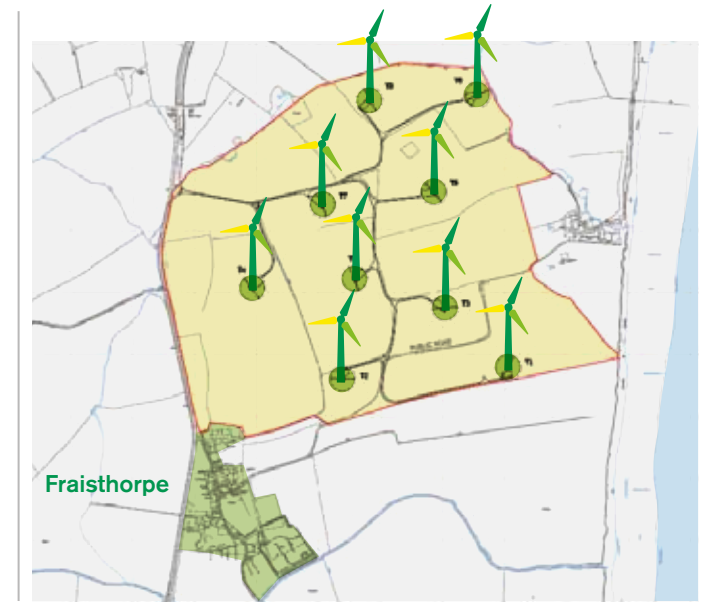
Project overview

Fraisthorpe Wind Farm is situated on agricultural land south of Bridlington and north of Barmston - with the closest settlement being the hamlet of Fraisthorpe.

Consented in 2013, the wind farm will consist of nine turbines with a total installed capacity of 29.7MW. BayWa r.e. acquired Fraisthorpe Wind Farm from TCI Renewables in December 2014.

BayWa r.e. will now progress construction of the project, with a view to commercial generation of electricity from the site in 2016.

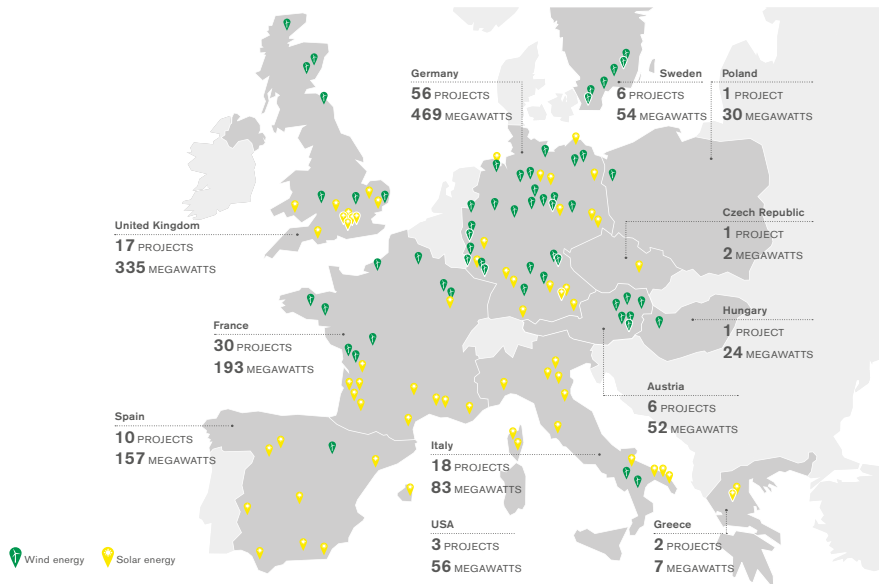
Construction staff will mobilise to site in April 2015, with offsite works related to the grid connection commencing soon after.



About BayWa r.e.

To date, the BayWa r.e group has installed onshore wind and solar projects in the UK with a total capacity of over 225MW and currently manages over 335MW.



On site activities

The key activity during the early stages of construction will be the establishment of the site compound.

Works will then progress on the rest of the site to develop access tracks and turbine foundations, prior to the arrival of turbine components later in the year.

Late 2015 - Early 2016	turbine erection
Mid 2016	generating electricity
